



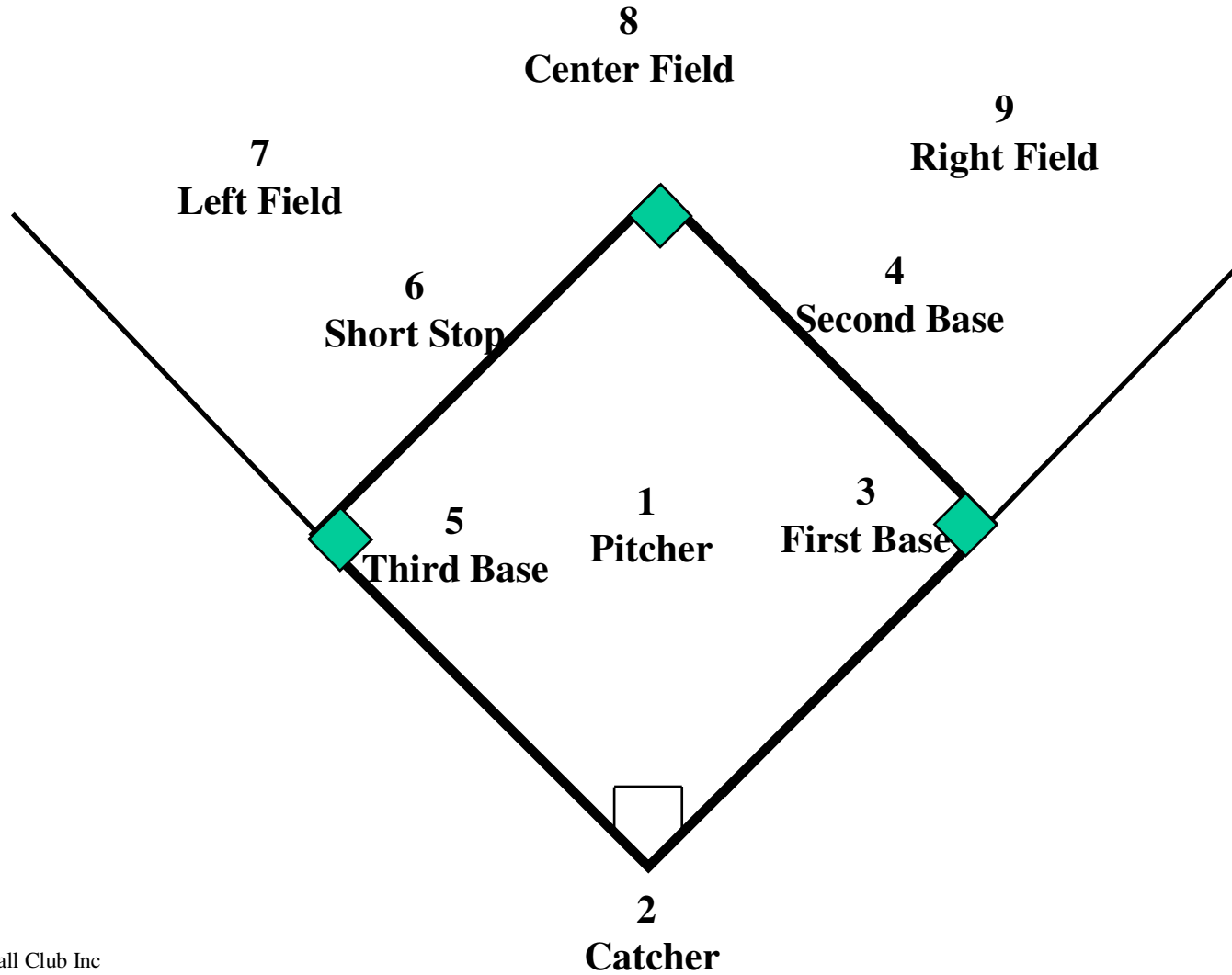
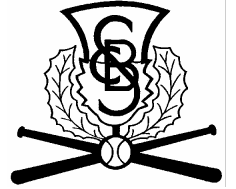

Fielding Position Numbers

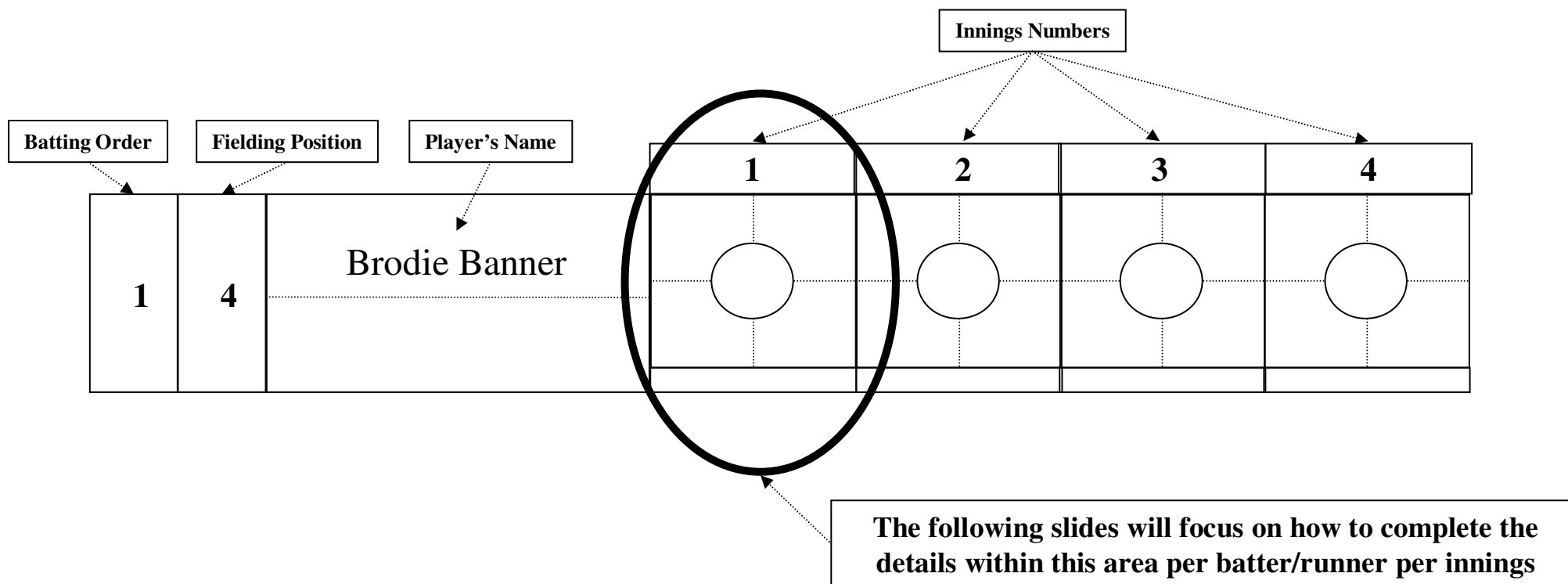




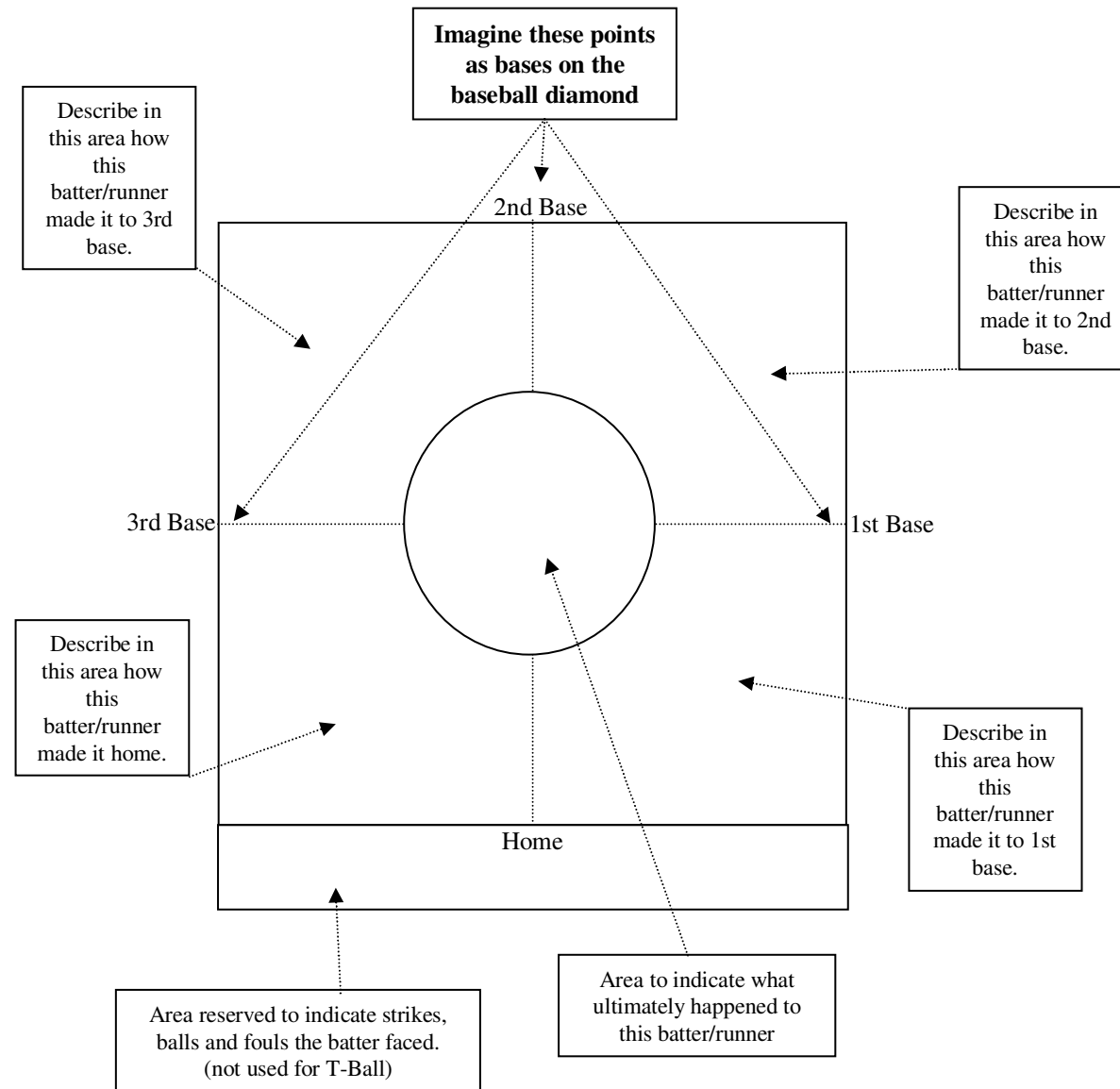
These slides are designed to introduce people to the concept of scoring Junior Baseball while specifically focusing on the simple requirements for T-Ball scoring.

Although scoring can become quite complex in seniors, the following pages are all that is required for the basics of scoring within the junior environment.

Below is a sample of one batter and the areas to be completed for the first four innings.

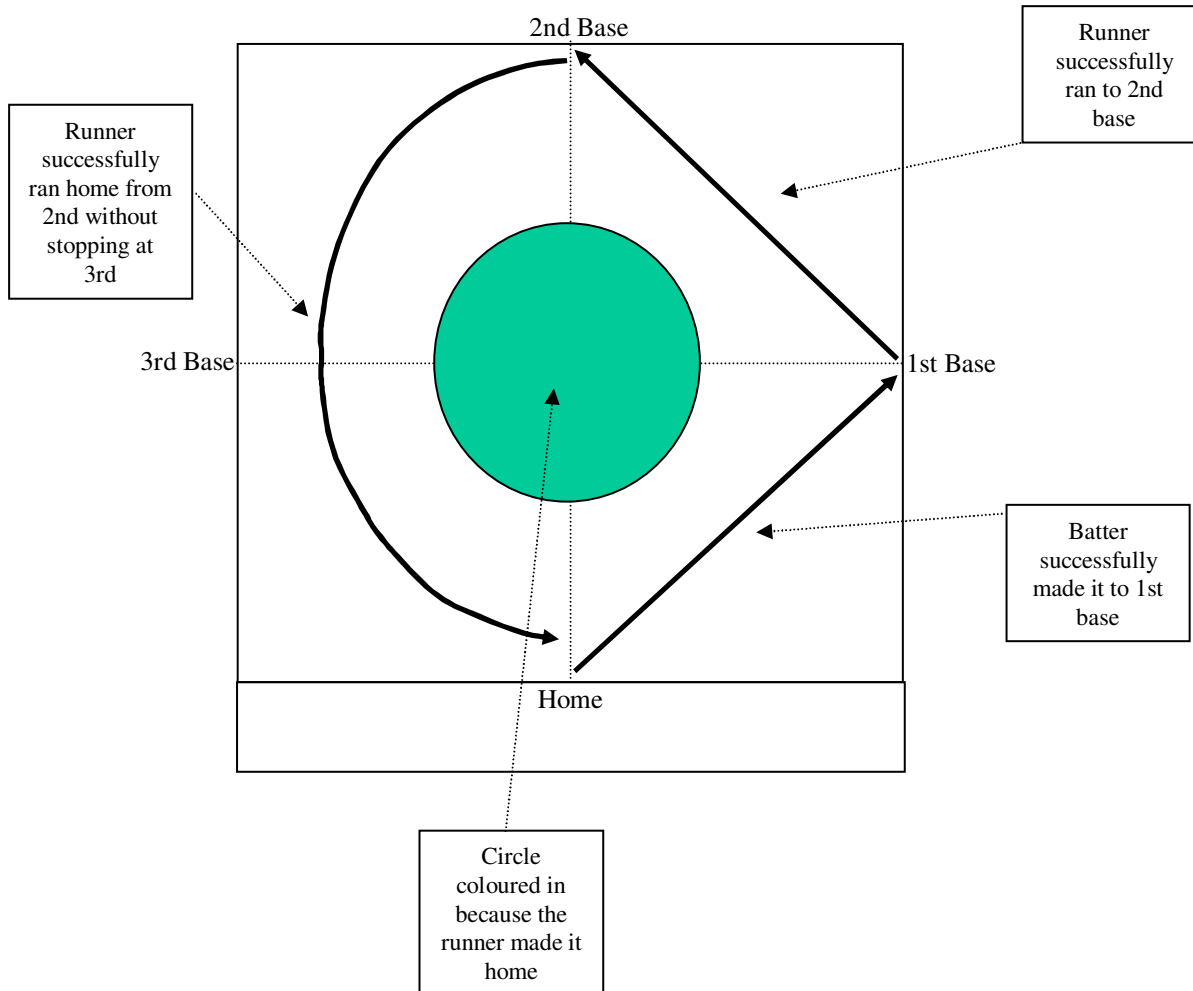


T-Ball Options to indicate how batter/runner progressed around diamond



- = Successfully made it to 1st base
- = Successfully made it to 2nd base
- = Successfully made it to 3rd base
- = Successfully made it to home
- = Successfully ran straight to 2nd base
- = Successfully ran from 1st to 3rd base
- = Successfully ran from 2nd base to home
- = Batter/runner made it home to score a run
- = Batter/runner was the 1st out for the innings
- = Batter/runner was the 2nd out for the innings
- = Batter/runner was the 3rd out for the innings
- = Runner was **Left On Base** and did not score

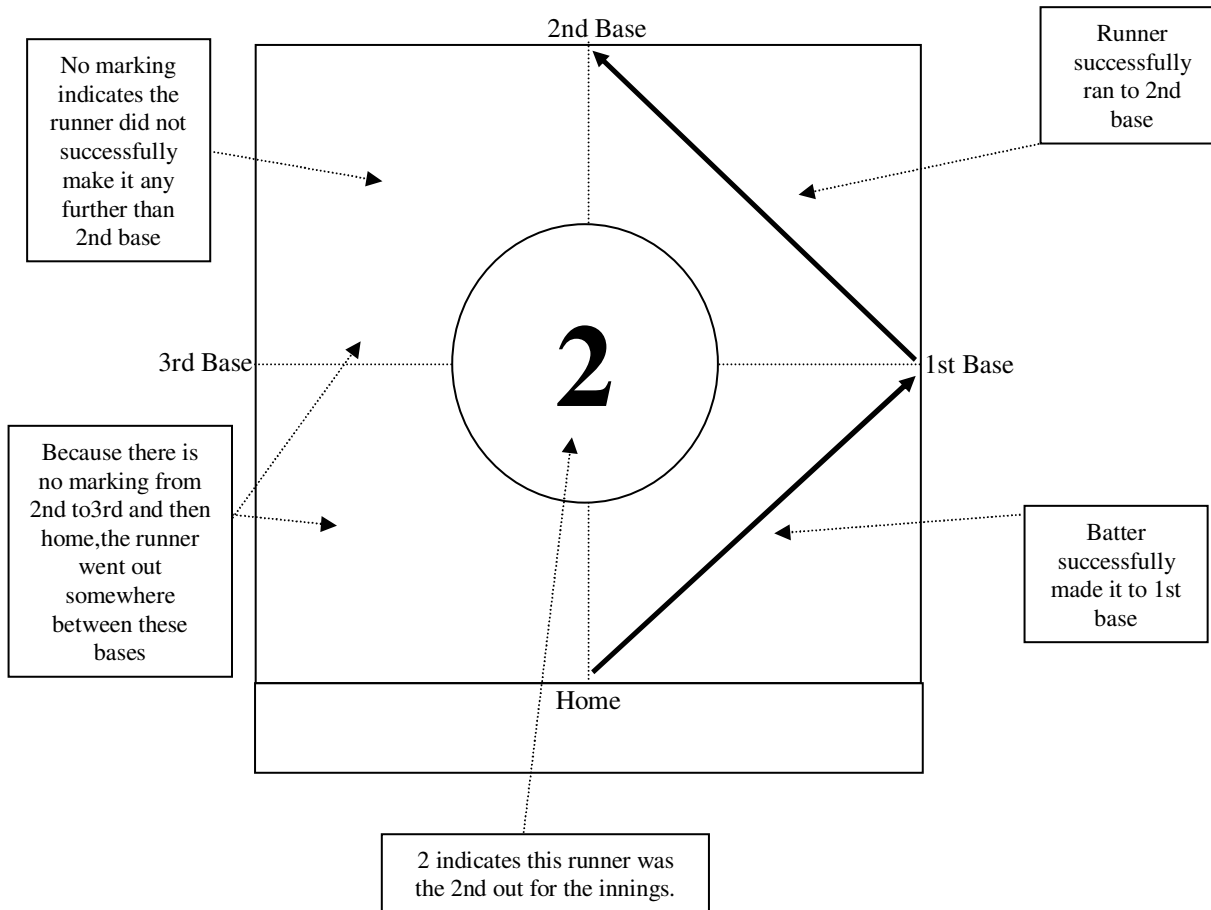

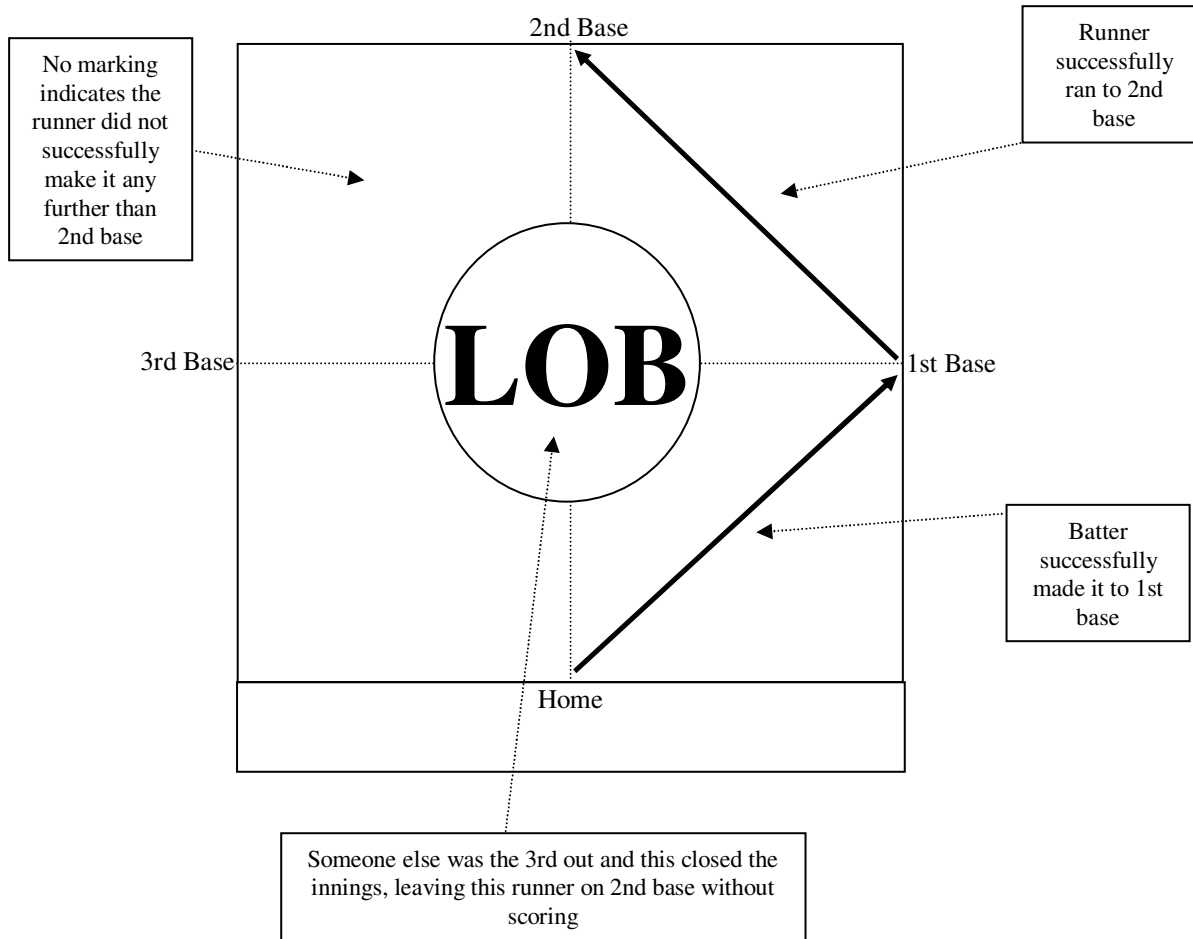

Fielding Position

Brodie is the 2nd out of innings

Sam is 3rd out of innings

Sam successfully reached 1st base but got out running to 2nd base when Kieren hit the ball

End of Innings markers

Opposition failed to get 3 out before all 9 batters, so innings ends and all runners left on base score (only T-Ball rule)

Tyler was left on base and did not score

Total runs for innings, will equal the number of coloured dots above

Running total of runs for game eg 16 + 4 = 20
